



James L. Nulman, an AV rated attorney with more than 25 years of litigation experience, is a Florida Supreme Court Certified Circuit Civil Mediator and Certified Appellate Mediator. He is also recognized as a mediator by the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, and is a Certified Family Mediator and a Florida State Qualified Arbitrator.

Litigation Experience

In 1980, Jim began practicing law in New Jersey. In 1983 he moved to Florida and joined the Fort Myers firm of Henderson, Franklin, Starnes & Holt, P.A. He became a shareholder of Henderson Franklin in 1989 and practiced with the firm until March 2006.

Jim's litigation practice was broadly based and involved many areas of commercial litigation, including contract disputes, corporate/partnership disputes, business torts, employment disputes, employee restrictive covenants, real estate litigation, brokerage disputes, negligence actions, as well as a host of other litigation matters. He also practiced all aspects of construction law and litigation, from the drafting of design and construction contracts to handling a wide variety of construction litigation and arbitration matters, representing owner/developers, contractors and design professionals.

Mediation Experience

Jim started mediating in the early 1990s and, in 1995, became certified by the Florida Supreme Court as a Circuit Civil Mediator and recognized as a mediator before the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida. He was one of the first attorneys in Southwest Florida to become certified as an Appellate Mediator in 2011.

In April 2006, he established **Nulman Mediation Services, Inc.**, a practice dedicated solely to providing mediation and arbitration services. While in the 1990s Jim mediated mostly commercial and construction disputes, over the years that has broadened significantly.

In addition to two-party mediations, Jim frequently handles multi-party mediations involving a dozen or more parties. While based in Southwest Florida, Jim mediates throughout the state.

Arbitration Experience

In addition to mediating, Jim has served as an arbitrator since the mid-1980s. He is state qualified and is frequently appointed as a non-binding arbitrator by the Twentieth Judicial Circuit Courts in Lee County and in Collier County, Florida. He also serves as a binding arbitrator, a special master and as an insurance appraiser and umpire.

Most often Jim serves as the sole arbitrator, but he has also served on arbitration panels. He has rendered decisions involving simple awards (merely stating the relief granted to the prevailing party), as well as reasoned decisions of between 10 and 30 pages, involving detailed findings of fact and conclusions of law. He often determines issues of entitlement to, and the amount of, recoverable attorneys' fees.

Jim served as a Special Master in a class action that was pending in the Twentieth Judicial Circuit Court in and for Lee County, Florida. The class action initially involved over 400 potential claimants. Ultimately, Jim administered and decided over 225 claims, and his findings and conclusions were approved in their entirety by the Circuit Court.

Faculty Affiliation

A member of the faculty of Mediation Training Group, Inc. since 2006, Jim participates in circuit civil training and speaks on various topics, including: mediation theory and practice, mediation techniques, negotiation dynamics, attorneys and mediation, the preparation of settlement agreements, basic legal concepts and financial issues inherent in mediation. Mediation Training Group, Inc. is one of a limited number of companies approved by the Florida Supreme Court to provide the training required for attorneys, judges and others to become certified mediators.
